GAME ON: WHY THERE'S NEVER BEEN A BETTER TIME TO BE A GAMER

Get games in your hands, on your head and on your TV too

This is a golden age for gaming. Services such as Xbox Game Pass and PlayStation Plus give you access to hundreds of games for a flat monthly fee, and there's a huge range of hardware from cutting-edge consoles and cute handhelds to virtual reality headsets. The only downside is that all that choice can make it hard to choose. We're here to help.

Cutting-edge consoles

The two big players in home gaming are Microsoft and Sony, with the Xbox Series S/X and PlayStation 5 respectively. Both firms are expected to launch slightly more powerful versions of their current consoles later this year, so if you're buying the existing ones try and get a discount: price cuts will be coming once the new consoles ship.

Both firms offer disc-free consoles, the Xbox Series S and PS5 Slim, which rely entirely on digital games. That saves money when you buy the console but it does mean you can't use second-hand game discs from the likes of CEX or eBay, so bear that in mind. But both Xbox and PlayStation have game subscription services that give you access to a library of popular games. Xbox Game Pass is £12.99 a month and the equivalent PlayStation Plus tier, which gives you new games as well as old ones, is £13.99 per month.

The other key console here is Nintendo's muchloved Switch, a handheld that can also connect to your TV.

Play on PC

There's also a world of gaming on PC, where you can access Microsoft's Game Pass for £7.99 per month or buy games individually on Steam, which is a massive library of PC games (and which is also available for Steam's handheld, the Steam Deck, as well as third-party gaming handhelds). Some PC games are also available in virtual reality for compatible headsets such as the HTC Vive, but those headsets are expensive and need quite powerful PCs too: the HTC Vive Pro 2 is £1,299.

Feel so real

If you want to play in virtual reality, there are two serious contenders right now: the Meta Quest and Sony's PSVR2. The Sony one needs to be connected to a PS5 but the Meta headsets – the 3 is the current one but the 2 is still widely available, much cheaper and a really good buy – are self-contained. You won't get big-name Sony games like Horizon: Call of the Mountain for Meta but there are tons of fun games for the platform, and you can also connect a PC to play some games on the headset too.

Xbox Series X

The best of Microsoft's current consoles is very powerful and still has a disc drive, so you can buy second-hand games. An Xbox Series X with a Game Pass Subscription is a tremendous gaming system. £409, argos.co.uk



PS5 Slim

This more affordable PlayStation 5 removes the disc drive and slims down the original's rather bulky box so you can fit it around your furniture. PS5 games tend to cost a little more but there are some spectacular titles to play. **£419, argos.co.uk**

Answering some of the most frequent asked questions about Hearing Aids

INVISIBLE AIDS

What are these invisible aids I see advertisied?

These are very small hearing aids that sit quite deeply in the ear canal and as such cannot be seen once in the ear. Legally they can be termed 'Invisible In The Ear' hearing aids. They are cosmetically the most discreet aids but are not for everybody.

WIRELESS HEARING AIDS

What are "Wireless" Hearing Aids?

The newest ranges of hearing aids are now mostly 'wireless'. This means they can be programmed whilst in the ear and can be operated via remote control if desired. The wearer can turn the volume up or down via a small remote control no bigger than a mobile phone. Some aids can be controlled via an 'App' on your phone and can stream phone calls directly from your mobile into your aids! We would advise whether your phone is compatible and set it all up for you. Wireless hearing aids can also communicate with each other to better simulate the spatial and temporal qualities of normal hearing.

French fancies Crepes suzette

Serves 2 Preparation time 20-25 minutes, plus resting Cooking time 10-15 minutes

A classic French favourite, the idea of flambéing crepes arose at the end of the 19th century. Not only do the flames look spectacular, they caramelise the sugar to sweet perfection!

Ingredients

- 70g plain flour
- 1 egg
- · A pinch of salt
- 50g caster sugar
- 150ml milk
- 70g soft butter, plus extra for frying
- Grated zest of an orange
- 20g icing sugar
- 4 tbsp orange liqueur

- Blend the flour, egg and salt in a bowl. Add the sugar and 50ml of the milk, and whisk to form a smooth batter.
- Melt 50g of the butter in a saucepan. Gradually add the remaining milk to the batter, then add the melted butter and half the grated orange zest. Let it rest in the fridge for at least 2 hours.
- 3. Heat a crepe or pancake pan over a medium heat. Very lightly grease the pan with a little melted butter. Using a ladle, pour roughly 2 tbsp of batter into the pan and swirl it around so the bottom of the pan is evenly coated. You want to use just enough batter to make a delicate, lacy crepe. Cook for about 45 seconds on one side until golden and then using a palette knife or fish slice, flip the crepe over and cook the other side for about 30 seconds until it freckles. Stack the crepes on a plate as you cook them. It's best to cover them, so they stay warm and don't dry out.
- For the orange crème, mix the icing sugar, the remaining grated orange zest and 20g soft butter in a bowl.
- 5. Spread some orange crème on each crepe and fold them to form a triangle.
- Ten minutes before serving the crepes, briefly warm them in an oven preheated to 170°C, fan 150°C, gas mark 3.
- 7. One by one, sprinkle the crepes with icing sugar in a pan and heat them up. In a separate small, deep pan or a small saucepan, heat the liqueur to approximately 40°C/100°F. Light the liqueur and pour it over the crepes. Serve straight away.





Beautiful blooms and the best type of lawns

May is all about flowers. Colour is popping up all over the garden, and it's also the month during which RHS Chelsea Flower Show steps into the limelight. It takes place this year from 21-25 May (visit www.rhs.org.uk for information).

One doesn't visit Chelsea to take home gardens 'off the shelf' but to absorb ideas and inspiration. There's no better place to view plant combinations, stunning trees, shrubs and perennials, landscaping possibilities, garden materials, tools and equipment. The wealth of knowledge which can be accessed at the Royal Hospital Grounds in Chelsea during the five days is freely and readily shared with visitors. No wonder people return home brimming with enthusiasm and flush with garden vigour. It marks the start of summer in the garden.

Marvellous May is when borders, balconies, doorsteps and window boxes can be beautified. Any outdoor space can support a plant or two, and they will bring multiple rewards to the soul. As soon as the danger of frost has passed, annual plants can stay outdoors. These are the ones that can flower repeatedly, from now right through to autumn, if they are fed, watered and tended regularly.



Love your lawn?

Sitting on grass in the spring sunshine is an excellent tonic and everyone should try to achieve a certain amount of it this month. Grass produces oxygen and captures carbon from the atmosphere. Natural turf creates a lush carpet that doesn't need to be cropped short every week. The traditional lawn is maintenance-hungry and offers very little for biodiversity. A looser, longer, informal grassy lawn is just as easy to sit on. In addition, it provides a healthy environment for birds, bees and garden insects.

The topic of artificial grass is a controversial one. If professionally laid, it provides a very low-maintenance surface. But it neither smells like grass nor acts similarly. If damaged, it can't repair itself. It has a limited life expectancy (normally between 10-20 years), after which it will usually end up in landfill. It looks lush and green all year round, whatever the weather, and some of the more expensive fake lawns can look very realistic. But some have been reported as becoming guite warm in the summer sunshine, rendering them almost unusable during hot weather. Artificial grass is incapable of cooling the atmosphere in the same way that natural grass can. Environmentally, it has very little in its favour, providing little or no food for any living creature. It has also been reported to absorb more radiation than living turf, thus potentially contributing to global warming.

Top tip for May

Wondering whether to tidy up your clematis this month? The easy-toremember advice 'if it flowers before June, don't prune' will tell you what type of pruning group your clematis falls into. The early-flowering clematis only need a very light clip after flowering. If you prune them before they bloom, you'll remove all the flower potential.

Illuminate your ablutions with lighting that's both practical and flattering.

Wash and glow

- The perfect bathroom lighting scheme is flexible enough to illuminate each area according to your needs. Combine general and decorative lights with 'work' lights – above the shower and either side of the washbasin, for example. You may want to add some clever touches, such as lowlevel lighting that comes on automatically when someone enters the room, or LED strips behind baffles or panels, which give a gentle glow from an invisible light source.
- Glass, crystal and metal fittings are great for maximising light and bouncing it around the room, as are mirrors. Combine a mirror with an LED light (perhaps with a concealed heat pad to avoid misting, a shaver socket and a Bluetooth speaker) and you've got everything in one.
- Strict regulations govern electrics within the bathroom and, depending on how close your fitting will be to water sources and splashing, you'll need specially designed lighting for safety, marked with an IP (ingress protection) rating appropriate to the zone in which it will be used. Ask for advice from your retailer, and always use a qualified electrician to carry out the work.

A watchdog report found that women born in the 1950's had been disadvantaged by 1995 and 2011 changes in State pension age from age 60 to age 65. Estimates indicate that each recipient is now 'owed' somewhere between \pounds 1,000 to \pounds 2,950, a total bill of about \pounds 7.7billion

From the start, Women Against State Pension Inequality (WASPI) was at the heart of the campaign. They say that some women only had 12 months' notice, and therefore had no realistic chance to plan and as a result many had to work for years longer and were unable to retire as expected.

On March 21st, the Parliamentary & Health Service Ombudsman (PHSO) concluded (after a 6-year investigation) that compensation payments should be made. Both the Department for Work & Pensions and Downing Street say they are considering the "complex" report, but I think the Government is unlikely to volunteer payments. Unfortunately, there is no timetable or deadline to resolve the issue.

For decades I have advised clients to make their own retirement contributions and not just rely on the State pension. This is the best chance of securing the retirement you want instead of relying on what a future Government might think you deserve.

THE AUDI TT: THEN AND NOW



As Audi discontinues its TT sports car after 25 years, we compare one of the first with one of the last. Ted Welford reports.

When Audi launched its TT in 1998, it was one of the most coveted new cars around. Its sleek design no doubt helped, but so did the fact this was a reasonably affordable sports car with topnotch quality and a fun driving experience.

The second-generation TT came along in 2006, with the most recent iteration arriving in 2014. But the TT will be discontinued shortly due to a fall in sales, an increased demand for SUVs and the need for electrification. As Audi draws the curtain on the TT, let's compare a Mk1 model with one of the last examples to be produced, a TTS Final Edition roadster.

My own car is a Quattro Sport – I'm a massive TT fanboy - which was essentially the 'final edition' for the first-generation TT, arriving in 2005, with an upgraded 1.8-litre turbocharged petrol engine putting out 237bhp (up from 222bhp in the standard TT). Other changes included more aerodynamic styling, new wheels and a contrasting black roof and mirrors. Audi also reduced the weight by removing the rear seats and fitting a strut brace.

Only 800 Quattro Sports were sold in the UK, though the Mk1 TT was never a rare car. Prices remain low, with tidy used examples available today from around \pounds 3,000, or \pounds 10,000 for a Quattro Sport model.

The new TT I tested is a sportier TTS Roadster model, using a 316bhp 2.0-litre petrol engine. With a 0-60mph time of 4.6 seconds, it is rapid, while the point-to-point pace, courtesy of its Quattro all-wheel-drive system, is exceptional. Few cars could keep up on the right road, and the all-weather traction in the Mk1 is nothing compared to the traction of this later car.

While the Audi TT's design has evolved, this latest car is instantly recognisable as a 'TT'. From the relatively compact dimensions to the wraparound bonnet and silver fuel filler cap, Audi has stayed faithful to the original, albeit fitting larger wheels and its latest LED lighting.

The similarities don't end there, though, as the Final Edition gets lashings of Alcantara around the minimalist interior. The original Mk1 featured various 'hidden' details, such as a 'TT' cover for the radio, while this new TTS has a clutterfree cabin. There's no touchscreen but rather a sizeable digital dial display called the Audi Virtual Cockpit, while the heated seat buttons and ventilation controls are housed within the air vents. It's a clever way of freeing up space without compromising on features or quality – something the original TT excelled at, too.

Behind the wheel, these cars have noticeable differences – not surprising given the 17-year age gap. Admittedly, my TT has done close to 100,000 miles, so probably isn't the tightest of examples, but with its engaging six-speed manual gearbox and peppy engine, it feels livelier than its younger sibling.

That's not to take away from this new TTS, though. The pace, even in inclement weather, is exceptional, so this is a sports car you should use every day rather than just sunnier ones. In the 'Dynamic' setting, the engine note and exhaust note liven up noticeably, though it lacks some of the engagement and fun of the Quattro Sport or rival sports cars like the Alpine A110 and a low-level Porsche Cayman.

Quality is excellent, and this feels like a premium product designed to last: Audi at its absolute finest. Even as my car approaches 20 years old, the Mk1 feels as well built inside as the day it was made. There are no rattles, everything still works, and I'd say it feels a lot nicer inside than plenty of far newer cars.

There's a slight price issue with the new car, with a new TTS Final Edition Roadster costing a steep £56,435, although that includes many luxuries like quilted leather seats, a Bang & Olufsen sound system and keyless entry. However, a 'standard' TT Final Edition can be had for £41,910, with a lesser engine and minus the Quattro ability.

It's rare for a car to gain 'icon' status in a period as short as 25 years, but the Audi TT has managed it. The Mk1 is destined to be a classic, and its design continues to be respected and applauded. Audi has consistently replicated that DNA with its later TT models, even to the end with this TTS Final Edition.

Let's hope Audi finds a way to distil the TT's brilliance into a future EV product, as this is a sports car with a legacy that deserves to last.





The basics of bathroom design

Whether you're redesigning your entire bathroom, adding an en suite or simply changing part of an existing room, we outline eleven simple steps to set you off on the right path.

Step one: consider who will use the room

Think about who will use the room and how. This helps you decide on fittings, how to arrange them and the overall style.

Step two: seek inspiration

Step three: ask for practical advice

Allow generous activity space and remember that changing the positions of pipework will increase the cost and inconvenience of the project.

Step five: don't forget storage

Any frequently used bathroom needs storage. Vanities including storage are useful, as are mirrored cabinets, shelves, rails and hooks,

Step six: design a lighting scheme

Plan early for wiring and fittings, and include general lighting and specific task lights - such as wall lamps on either side of the mirror. Always use a qualified professional for the installation.

Step seven: decide how to keep warm

Work out the heat output required and choose a radiator, heated towel rail and/or underfloor heating. Underfloor heating gives a more usable floor area and a more flexible plan.

Step eight: choose wall and floor surfaces

It's not obligatory to tile every wall - provided vulnerable areas are protected, paint or moistureresistant wallpaper can be used elsewhere. Flooring should be non-slip, resistant to water and humidity, easy to clean and comfortable. Options include vinyl, tiles, engineered wood, cork or rubber.

Step nine: remember the importance of taps

Quality taps and shower controls offer improved durability, but they must feel comfortable and pleasant. Beautiful taps can elevate a plain white bath or basin, and the same goes for shower controls, shower heads, handles, door knobs and switches.

Step ten: dress your windows

For privacy, frosted window film is cheap and versatile, while a simple roller blind lets you add colour and texture. Plantation shutters are attractive and adjustable.

Step eleven: add personality with accessories

Bathroom accessories such as woven bath mats, glass storage vases, ceramic soap dishes and soft towels create atmosphere and character. If the room isn't too humid, add prints on the walls, and include plants to connect with nature and add a sense of well-being.

Fish for compliments Alaska salmon tagine

Serves 4 Preparation time 5 minutes Cooking time 20 minutes

Wow family and friends – and make entertaining easy – with this Moroccan-inspired tagine-style dish, served up in less than 30 minutes!

Ingredients

- 4 x 125g Wild Alaska salmon fillets
- · 2 tbsp olive or vegetable oil
- · ·1 onion, peeled and sliced
- · 1 tsp cumin seeds or ground cumin
- · 2 tsp ground paprika
- 1 x 400g tin chopped tomatoes
- · 1 x 298g tin mandarin segments, drained
- 1 tsp vegetable stock powder
- 50g sultanas
- 100g baby spinach
- 150g couscous
- · Chopped fresh coriander, to garnish

- 1. Remove the skin from the salmon fillets, if preferred.
- Heat the oil in a large frying pan and cook the onion for 3-4 minutes. Add the cumin and paprika and fry gently for about 20-30 seconds.
- 3. Stir in the tomatoes, mandarin segments, vegetable stock powder and sultanas. Cook for 5 minutes, then add the spinach and stir it in as the leaves wilt.
- Arrange the salmon fillets on top of the tomato mixture. Cover with a lid or a piece of greased foil and cook over a medium-low heat for 8-10 more minutes.
- 5. Meanwhile, cook the couscous according to pack instructions. Serve with the salmon tagine, garnished with chopped fresh coriander.

JOINT ACCOUNTS: SENSIBLE OR STUPID?



Joint bank or savings accounts can be a good idea for those in long-term, trusting and stable relationships but you should be aware of the pitfalls before pooling your financial resources.

- Understand the legal implications of a joint account. In most cases, both parties are equally liable for any debts or overdrafts incurred on the account, regardless of who made the transactions. If you are concerned about this, you can have an account where both parties must authorise the release of funds. However, if you feel you need to do this, it might be a sign you shouldn't be joining forces.
- If it's not practical to have two signatories for every transaction, be aware that one person will have the legal right to withdraw all the money.
- For current accounts, you'll need to discuss and agree upon how the account will be used, who will deposit money, who will pay bills, and what the spending limits are.
- Particularly if you are pooling day-to-day spending, bear in mind that relationship conflict can arise if one party considers the other is spending unnecessarily or paying a higher price for goods than they should.
- If you are feeling pressured to open a joint account, particularly if it's early in the relationship, ask for someone clse's opinion. It might just be that you are apprehensive about the step change in your commitment, but equally, your reticence could have grounds.
- It's essential to have a plan in place for what happens to the joint funds if the relationship ends or if one of the account holders falls ill. Discuss and document this plan beforehand to avoid potential conflicts in the future.

A survey of over 24,000 people on the MoneySavingExpert website showed a marked difference between the generations in the adoption of shared funds.

Who manages the money?


Whether you have a joint account for everything or just for bills, it's likely there's one person in the relationship who is better at money management. They may have more of an aptitude for it or have more time to keep an eye on things.

This suits many partnerships, and you aren't going to force a change just for the sake of it. However, for the non-managing party, burying their head in the sand and not knowing how to access accounts is dangerous. If you lose your partner or they become incapacitated, not having access to your own money is going to pile on the stress.

Create a factsheet detailing all your products: savings, debts, insurance, bank accounts and important financial dates such as when car insurance is due for renewal. If the nonmanaging partner is IT literate then an online shared file will be fine, but printing it out will be easier for most. Of course, don't put important passwords on the same piece of paper.

In summary, having a joint account can be a very convenient part of your daily life together, provided you've discussed and planned how to manage funds, both now and should circumstances change.




